PUBLIC TESTIMONY on SB 800 From Triangle Lake Pesticide Victims United

Triangle Lake Pesticide Poisoning Victims United consists of entirely of persons that have had timber industry herbicides found in our urine.

100% of the nearly forty of us tested by renowned pesticide exposure expert Dr Dana Barr (currently of Emory University, formerly ran the labs at the U.S. governments Center for Disease Control) were found to have have both 2,4-D and atrazine in our urine; those of us given second tests within 48 hours of aerial sprays of those herbicides near our homes had our levels spike, demonstrating causal relationship. Thus, IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO US THAT SB 800 BE MADE LAW, as it is one step in the right direction, though other reforms are also needed to protect the public health in Oregon.

SB 800 will enable us -- the public who are verifiably being poisoned against our will -- to at least have access to the spray records via DEQ. It really is a crime that we don't already have that access, and we appreciate both Mr Holvey and Prozanski for their effort on SB 800.
