- HB 2624 Authorizes counties to exempt themselves from the statewide ban on the use of dogs to pursue cougars and black bears by a vote of the people of that county.
- HB 3395 Authorizes a pilot program to allow the use of dogs to pursue cougars in certain management zones.

No, No. We the voters have already said no. It is a totally unnecessary way to hunt. What dog owner would send his dog out to die or be mauled by a wild animal. What a cruel way to die. No humane person would do this to their dog. Hunting in our state is a tradition, but not hunting with dogs, which is almost as cruel and inhumane as dog fighting. Please say NO. Thank you, Bonnie
