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**WHAT THE BILL DOES:** Modifies the method by which moneys from the State School Fund (SSF) are distributed to school districts to pay for the Long Term Care and Treatment program. Applies the method beginning with the 2013-14 SSF distribution. Takes effect on July 1, 2013.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

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**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:**

**BACKGROUND:** Currently the Long Term Care and Treatment program receives about \$17 million per biennium from the State School Fund. According to the Oregon Department of Education preliminary analysis, HB 2956, if implemented, would distribute about \$42 million per biennium to the program. The implementation of this bill means that there would be about \$25 million less formula revenue available for distribution to school districts and education service districts per biennium.

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
