As representatives of the Oregon Stroke Network, we look forward to the success of this bill, and the work of the resulting committee, to create a path ensuring that the highest standard of stroke care is accessible to all Oregonians, including equal access to <u>acute</u> stroke treatment. In addition, we support the establishment of quality measures and a state data base to assess and guide the quality of stroke care provided to Oregonians.
