
Construction Contractors Board Agency Overview




 Protects the public's interest in improvements to real property, and promotes a competitive business environment in Oregon.

• The Board:

- Provides protections for customers and workers in Oregon's construction industry.
- Issues construction related licenses and certificates.
- Administers pre-licensure testing and continuing education.
- Enforces contractor licensing and business practices laws.
- Provides dispute resolution services.
