



**Oregon needs a health care study -  
Now we have the chance to get one: HB 3260**

**Keep health care reform in Oregon alive and well. Take action NOW.**

The Oregon House Health Care Committee will consider a ***study of health care financing options in Oregon***. Fifteen other states and the federal government already conducted over 25 studies, but not Oregon. Oregon needs this study if it ever wants to achieve effective health care reform.

HB 3260 is sponsored by state Representatives Michael Dembrow and Jennifer Williamson with two co-sponsors, Senators Chip Shields and Laurie Monnes Anderson. The House hearing ***is April 5<sup>th</sup>***; the Senate hearing is not yet scheduled.

If this bill passes, the Oregon Health Authority will supervise a study comparing at least four ***options for health care financing***:


1. Implementing the ***Affordable Care Act*** without modification,
2. Adding a ***public option*** in the state insurance exchange,
3. Statewide ***single payer*** health care, and...
4. "Other."

This study will be privately funded. There is no cost to taxpayers.
