We believe and support the changes in:

SB 0633 SECTION 1. (1) (b) completion of 12 credit hours of continued education within the 3 year dealer license renewal time frame. We fully support the changes that designates that no dealer can repeat a course which they have previously received continued education credits. (4) We also support a standard review of continued education and testing program every two years by all organizations providing education.

SECTION 3. (1-4) We stand behind the dealerships ability to designate an employee who qualifies with in the amendments of this section to except and take responsibility in all aspects of precertification and continued education classes.
