BACKGROUND:

Businessman and philanthropist Mario Pastega passed away on January 20, 2012. Following his service in United States Navy during World War II, Mr. Pastega moved to Corvallis to expand his investment in the soft drink industry, with the purchase of a second Pepsi-Cola bottling plant. His success in the soft drink industry allowed him to invest in his time, energy, and financial resources into his community.

Mr. Pastega established the Mario and Alma Pastega Golden Apple Award for excellence in service within the Corvallis School District; supported scholarships at Oregon State University, Western Oregon University and Linn-Benton Community College. He led the fundraising efforts for the Good Samaritan Regional Cancer Center in Corvallis; renovation of Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center intensive care unit and outpatient surgery center; and Ralph Hull Regional Heart Center. His philanthropic work in education and health care led to his recognition with the Oregon Philanthropy Award; Corvallis Senior First award; and Oregon Ethic in Business Award
