Requires court finding of prejudice for violations of speedy trial requirement.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to speedy trial; amending ORS 135.747; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 135.747 is amended to read:
- 5 135.747. (1) If a defendant charged with a crime[, whose trial has not been
- 6 postponed upon the application of the defendant or by the consent of the de-
- 7 fendant,] is not brought to trial within a reasonable period of time, and the
- 8 **defendant did not consent to or request the delay,** the court shall order
- 9 the accusatory instrument to be dismissed[.] upon the showing of actual
- 10 prejudice or presumptive prejudice to the defendant.
- 11 (2) As used in this section:
- 12 (a) "Actual prejudice" means:
- 13 (A) Excessive pretrial incarceration;
- 14 (B) Impairment to the defense; or
- 15 (C) Humiliation, anxiety or indignity suffered by the defendant as 16 a result of the delay.
- 17 (b) "Presumptive prejudice" means prejudice caused by a delay so 18 excessive and unreasonable that it shocks the conscience.
- SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de-

clared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
