## **SUMMARY**

Prescribes duties for specified scientific and technical advisory committee and gives committee authority to select members.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

5	SECTION 1. ORS 196.451 is amended to read:
6	196.451. (1) [To aid and advise the Ocean Policy Advisory Council in the
7	performance of its functions, the council] The Ocean Policy Advisory
8	Council shall establish a permanent scientific and technical advisory com-
9	mittee chaired by the director of the Sea Grant College program or other
10	similarly qualified member of the [Ocean Policy Advisory Council and may
11	establish additional committees as needed] council.
12	(2) The committee shall consist of members:
13	(a) Appointed by the council; or
14	(b) Selected according to the procedures described in subsection (4)
15	of this section.

- 17 (a) Aid and advise the council in the performance of the council's functions.
- 19 (b) Advise, subject to the availability of funds and time, state 20 agencies on matters related to this state's ocean or nearshore re-

1 sources.

- (4) If the committee determines that it is not equipped to perform its research duties, the committee may select individuals for committee membership according to the following procedures:
- (a) The committee first must determine that a new discipline needs to be represented by the committee.
- (b) After determining that a new discipline needs to be represented, the committee must solicit the names of candidates from the public.
- (c) The committee must evaluate the expertise of the candidates, nominate candidates for committee membership and solicit feedback from the public on those nominations. In evaluating and nominating candidates under this paragraph, the committee must consider the candidate's expertise and availability and any potential or actual conflict of interest.
- (d) After receiving feedback from the public, the committee may select a new member from among the candidates.
- (5) In accordance with ORS chapter 183, the council shall adopt rules for the administration of subsection (4) of this section.
- [(2)] (6) The council may establish additional advisory committees as needed. Members of any advisory committee established under this section [Members of the advisory committees] are not entitled to compensation, but in the discretion of the council may be reimbursed from funds available to council for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by them in the performance of their official duties, subject to ORS 292.495.
- SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
