Oregon Health and Science University Agency Overview




General Fund is less than 2 percent of the public corporation's total budget

 Master Tobacco Settlement Funds (Other Funds) pays debt service on \$200 million in general obligation bonds for the Opportunity Program






 - OHSU Support Fund continued at 2011-13 LAB
 - No policy packages
- Modification to Governor's budget:
 - OHSU Support Fund increased by \$1,066,209 to correct calculation error
