We write to offer our support for extending the Farmworker Housing Tax Credit, also called the Agriculture Workforce Housing Tax Credit. This incentive is one component of the City of Portland's agenda in support of rural communities. We view this tax credit as an important policy that benefits rural Oregon while collectively enhancing growth and vitality across the state.

Both Senate Bill 323 and House Bill 2980 will extend the tax credit in order to help farmers, non-profits, and others build housing for the workers needed to harvest Oregon's diverse crops.
