
Abandoned and Derelict Vessels


Haul out and tow: \$ 380 Storage: \$300/month = \$900


Vessel has not been registered since 1993; unable to locate owner





Current process: ORS 830.912, 830.927, 98.245





HB 2233 saves money and protects the environment:

- Allows the Marine Board to use the salvaged vessel fund as soon as vessel meets the definition of "abandoned" or "derelict," and to recover costs from the owner of the vessel.
- Authorizes the salvaged vessel fund to be used for a vessel turn-in program to encourage owners to surrender vessels before they become a navigational hazard or environmental threat.
