Chair Prozanski and Committee Members,

Thank you for giving me the opportunity to testify regarding HB 3253 which received unanimous support from the House. This measure would ensure that Oregon does not inadvertently incentivize sex offenders moving into the jurisdiction of Oregon in order to avoid the sex registration requirements that they were sentenced under in a different state.

HB 3253 is prospective, not retroactive. Essentially this bill applies to offenders convicted of an offense or adjudicated for an act on or after the effective date of this act. Additionally, this bill would apply to the requirement under federal law as well.

This bill is supported by Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) and Vi Beaty from the Oregon State Police SOR Unit. Please support HB 3253 as is with no amendments.
