WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Directs agencies to include active servicemembers’ federal right to stay proceedings with other required notices to parties.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

BACKGROUND: Oregon currently requires agencies to notify parties of certain rights and procedures in advance of hearings in contested cases, and of their right to a hearing generally. Senate Bill 125 adds to these notices, information regarding active duty servicemembers’ right stay proceedings under the Servicemember Civil Relief Act.

(SBs 45 and 125 are almost identical; SB 125 is a bit more comprehensive.)
