



STOP HB 3509

House Bill 3509 Relating to sex offender treatment; Authorizes counties to regulate location of sex offender treatment facilities.




Who commits sex crimes?





94% of all sex crimes are committed by first-time sex offenders .


WHO ARE THE OFFENDERS?

Across a variety of age ranges, the percentage of sexual assaults against juveniles by strangers was relatively low.






Recommendations

1. REJECT HB 3509 because it will create county-level political brush fires all over the state where counties will likely push treatment providers to out-of-the-way zones.

Recommendations

2. A new bill is needed that sets state-wide allowances for licensed sex offender treatment providers to locate in ordinary neighborhoods such as Portland's Sellwood and Neighbors of Upper Southeast Portland for reasons based on facts not hysteria.
