Re: SB 835

Dear Legislators:

While my day job is practicing law, I also breed and train foundation performance Quarter Horses. You know me from my previous attempts at trying to prevent other kinds of foreseeable harm (HB 2520), but today I'm here on behalf of Oregonians who can't speak for themselves, to support SB 835.
