I strongly object to the changes purposed in HB2093. Specifically, I object to the amended language in SECTION 32. ORS 432.115 paragraph (4) and the removal of SECTION 33. ORS 432.121 paragraph (2) (c). Genealogy is a hobby of mine, and while I appreciate the need for protection of individual privacy, removal of birth, death, marriage, and divorce records from any access for such an extended period is a deterrent to researching and proving family lines.

Changing when these records are available does nothing to protect a person's identity, especially when the provisions to protect social security numbers and other information is already in place.

I urge you to vote Nay on HB2093.
