Affirmative action policy: See ORS 182.100. Diversity criteria: See ORS 236.115.

- Nine members, geographic balance to be considered
  - Five must be Registered Nurses (CARNEGIE, Salem; TENSCHER, Portland; MILL, Coos Bay; HICKMANN, Bend; KOSTELECKY, West Linn)
    - One must be a certified nursing assistant (CAIN)
    - One nurse practitioner (TENSCHER)
  - Two must be Licensed Professional Nurses (COON, Portland; WILLIS, Corvallis)
    - At least one nursing educator (CARNEGIE)
    - At least one nursing administrator (KOSTELECKY)
    - At least two non-supervisory nurses involved with direct patient care (HICKMANN, MILL)
  - Two public members (WAYMAN, Portland; SOUEDE, Portland)
- Members shall be appointed for three-year terms
- A board member shall be removed immediately if the member is not a resident of the state, has been absent from three consecutive board meetings, without at least one excused absence, and not licensed and good standing at time of retirement

**DUTIES AND AUTHORITY:** ORS 678.150 to 678.164 and ORS 678.360 to 678.445

- Elect a president, president-elect, and secretary
- Determine qualifications of nursing applicants; exercise general supervision over the practice of nursing in the state
- Examine, license, and renew the licenses of qualified licensees; prescribe standards and set curricula for nursing education programs
- Accredite nursing education programs; deny or withdraw accreditation from education programs that fall below prescribed standards
- Prescribe standards for the delegation of duties to nursing assistants
- Hire and define duties and fix salary of executive director
- Bring suit to enjoin violators under board authority; subpoena for board investigations
- Rule making for nursing care in local correctional facilities and juvenile detention facilities, detox, adult foster care, training and treatment centers
- Issue certificate of special competency for nurse practitioners
- Prepare curricula and standards for training of nursing assistants
