## SUMMARY

Imposes restrictions on issuance of marijuana grow site registration cards under Oregon Medical Marijuana Act. Modifies production limits at marijuana grow sites.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to marijuana grow sites; creating new provisions; amending ORS

3 475.304 and 475.320; and declaring an emergency.

## 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 475.304 is amended to read:

6 475.304. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall establish by rule a 7 marijuana grow site registration system to authorize production of marijuana 8 by a registry identification cardholder, a designated primary caregiver who 9 grows marijuana for the **registry identification** cardholder or a person who 10 is responsible for a marijuana grow site. The marijuana grow site registra-11 tion system [*adopted*] must require a registry identification cardholder to 12 submit an application to the authority that includes:

13 (a) The name of the person responsible for the marijuana grow site;

14 (b) The address of the marijuana grow site;

(c) The registry identification card number of the registry cardholder forwhom the marijuana is being produced; and

17 (d) Any other information the authority considers necessary.

18 (2)(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, the 19 authority shall issue a marijuana grow site registration card to a registry 20 identification cardholder who has met the requirements of subsection (1) of 1 this section.

(b) The authority may not issue a marijuana grow site registration
card to a registry identification cardholder if:

4 (A) Three or more marijuana grow site registration cards have al-5 ready been issued for a marijuana grow site located at the address 6 submitted by the applicant;

(B) The marijuana grow site is located within 1,000 feet of the real
property comprising a public or private elementary, secondary or career school attended primarily by minors; or

10 (C) A city or county has adopted an ordinance that prohibits a 11 marijuana grow site from being located at the address submitted by 12 the applicant.

(3) [A person who has been issued a marijuana grow site registration card
under this section] The person responsible for a marijuana grow site
must display the marijuana grow site registration card at the marijuana
grow site at all times when marijuana is being produced.

17 (4) A marijuana grow site registration card must be obtained and 18 [*posted*] **displayed** for each registry identification cardholder for whom 19 marijuana is being produced at a marijuana grow site.

(5) All usable marijuana[,] **and all** plants, seedlings and seeds associated with the production of **the usable** marijuana for a registry identification cardholder by [a] **the** person responsible for a marijuana grow site are the property of the registry identification cardholder and must be provided to the registry identification cardholder upon request.

(6)(a) The authority shall conduct a criminal records check under ORS
181.534 of [any] a person whose name is submitted as [a] the person responsible for a marijuana grow site.

(b) A person convicted of a Class A or Class B felony under ORS 475.752 to 475.920 for the manufacture or delivery of a controlled substance in Schedule I or Schedule II may not be issued a marijuana grow site registration card or produce marijuana for a registry identification cardholder for

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1 five years from the date of conviction.

(c) A person convicted more than once of a Class A or Class B felony
under ORS 475.752 to 475.920 for the manufacture or delivery of a controlled
substance in Schedule I or Schedule II may not be issued a marijuana grow
site registration card or produce marijuana for a registry identification
cardholder.

7 (7) A registry identification cardholder or the designated primary 8 caregiver of the **registry identification** cardholder may reimburse the per-9 son responsible for a marijuana grow site for the costs of supplies and util-10 ities associated with the production of marijuana for the registry 11 identification cardholder. No other costs associated with the production of 12 marijuana for the registry identification cardholder, including the cost of 13 labor, may be reimbursed.

(8) The authority may adopt rules imposing a fee in an amount established
by the authority for registration of a marijuana grow site and for conducting a criminal records check under this section.

17 **SECTION 2.** ORS 475.320 is amended to read:

18 475.320. (1)(a) A registry identification cardholder or the designated pri-19 mary caregiver of the **registry identification** cardholder may possess up to 20 six mature marijuana plants and 24 ounces of usable marijuana.

(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this subsection, if a registry identification cardholder has been convicted of a Class A or Class B felony under ORS 475.752 to 475.920 for the manufacture or delivery of a controlled substance in Schedule I or Schedule II, the registry identification cardholder or the designated primary caregiver of the **registry identification** cardholder may possess one ounce of usable marijuana at any given time for a period of five years from the date of the conviction.

(2) A person authorized under ORS 475.304 to produce marijuana at a
 marijuana grow site:

30 (a) May produce marijuana for **a registry identification cardholder** and 31 provide marijuana to a registry identification cardholder or [*that person's*]

the registry identification cardholder's designated primary caregiver as
 authorized under this section.

3 (b) May possess up to six mature plants and up to 24 ounces of usable
4 marijuana for each registry identification cardholder [or caregiver] for
5 whom marijuana is being produced.

6 (c) May produce marijuana for no more than [*four*] **three** registry iden-7 tification cardholders [*or designated primary caregivers*] concurrently.

8 (d) Must [*obtain and*] display a marijuana grow site registration card is-9 sued under ORS 475.304 for each registry identification cardholder [*or des-*10 *ignated primary caregiver*] for whom marijuana is being produced.

(e) Must provide all marijuana produced for a registry identification cardholder [or designated primary caregiver] to the cardholder [or caregiver] at the time the person responsible for a marijuana grow site ceases producing marijuana for the cardholder [or caregiver].

(f) Must return the marijuana grow site registration card to the registry identification cardholder to whom the card was issued when requested to do so by the **registry identification** cardholder or when the person responsible for a marijuana grow site ceases producing marijuana for the **registry identification** cardholder [*or caregiver*].

(3) Except as provided in subsections (1) and (2) of this section, a registry
identification cardholder, the designated primary caregiver of the registry
identification cardholder and the person responsible for a marijuana grow
site producing marijuana for the registry identification cardholder may possess a combined total of up to six mature plants and 24 ounces of usable
marijuana for that registry identification cardholder.

(4)(a) A registry identification cardholder and the designated primary
caregiver of the **registry identification** cardholder may possess a combined
total of up to 18 marijuana seedlings or starts as defined by rule of the
Oregon Health Authority.

30 (b) A person responsible for a marijuana grow site may possess up to 18 31 marijuana seedlings or starts as defined by rule of the authority for each

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registry identification cardholder for whom the person responsible for the
 marijuana grow site is producing marijuana.

3 <u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) The amendments to ORS 475.304 by section 1 of this
 4 2013 Act apply to applications for registration of a marijuana grow site
 5 submitted on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.

6 (2) The amendments to ORS 475.320 by section 2 of this 2013 Act 7 apply to marijuana grow sites for which an application for registration 8 of a marijuana grow site is submitted on or after the effective date 9 of this 2013 Act.

10 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate pres-11 ervation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de-12 clared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.

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
