The American Academy of Pediatrics, World Health Organization and United States Surgeon General all agree...

When a mother's own milk is not available, human donor milk is the best alternative

1 IN 9 INFANTS ARE BORN PREMATURE



Our mission is to collect, pasteurize and distribute donor human milk for medical need.

THE DEMAND FOR DONOR MILK IS GROWING

In 2010, the 11 milk banks in the United States dispensed 2 million ounces of human donor milk

The estimated need was 8 million ounces



HMBANA (HUMAN MILK BANKING ASSOCIATION OF NORTH AMERICA)

- 12 Milk Banks exist in North America
- The closest milk banks are over 600 miles away
- Hospitals in our state order milk from San Jose or Denver
- Milk must be shipped frozen, overnight, on dry ice
- Shipping fees are VERY costly

HOW DOES A NON-PROFIT MILK BANK WORK?

Milk donors are identified within our communities (hospitals, moms groups, social media)

Healthy, non-smoking women with milk in excess of their own babies needs


All milk donors undergo health screenings and blood testing to ensure health and quality of milk

- 100,000 ounces by 2015


