Requires sex offender who is released into Oregon, who is placed on probation in Oregon or who moves into Oregon, to register as sex offender if jurisdiction of conviction requires registration

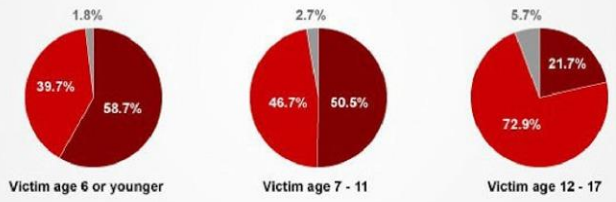

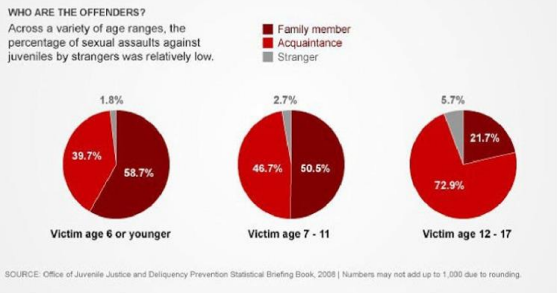

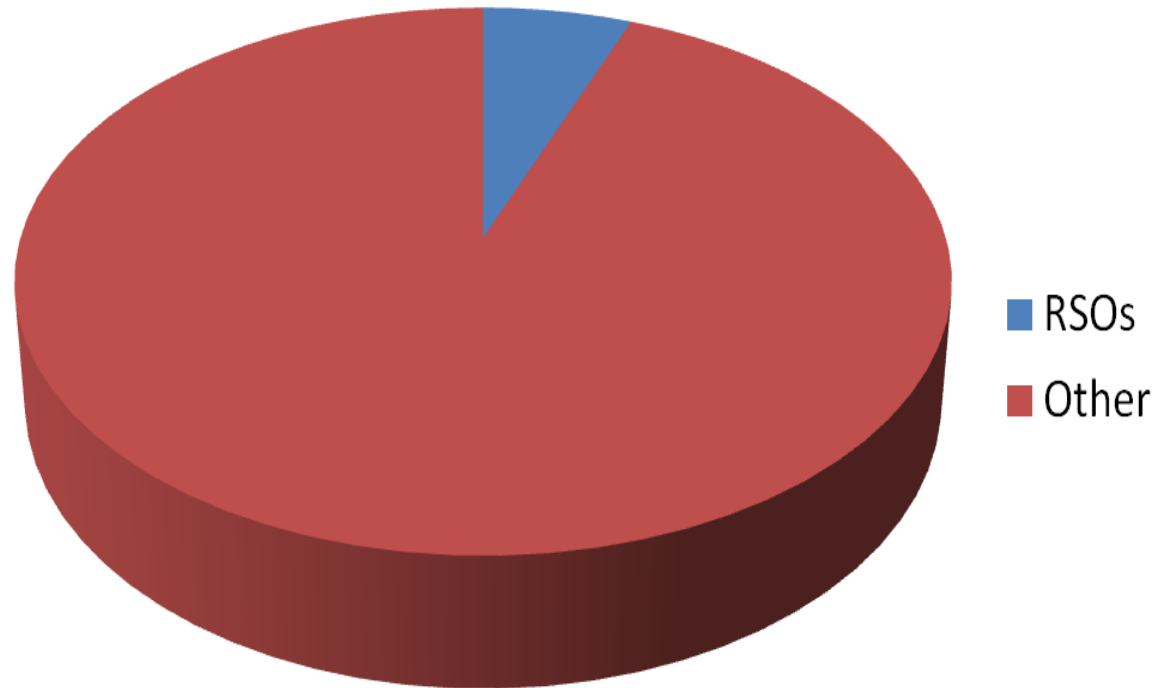

Who are these Sex Offending Strangers?



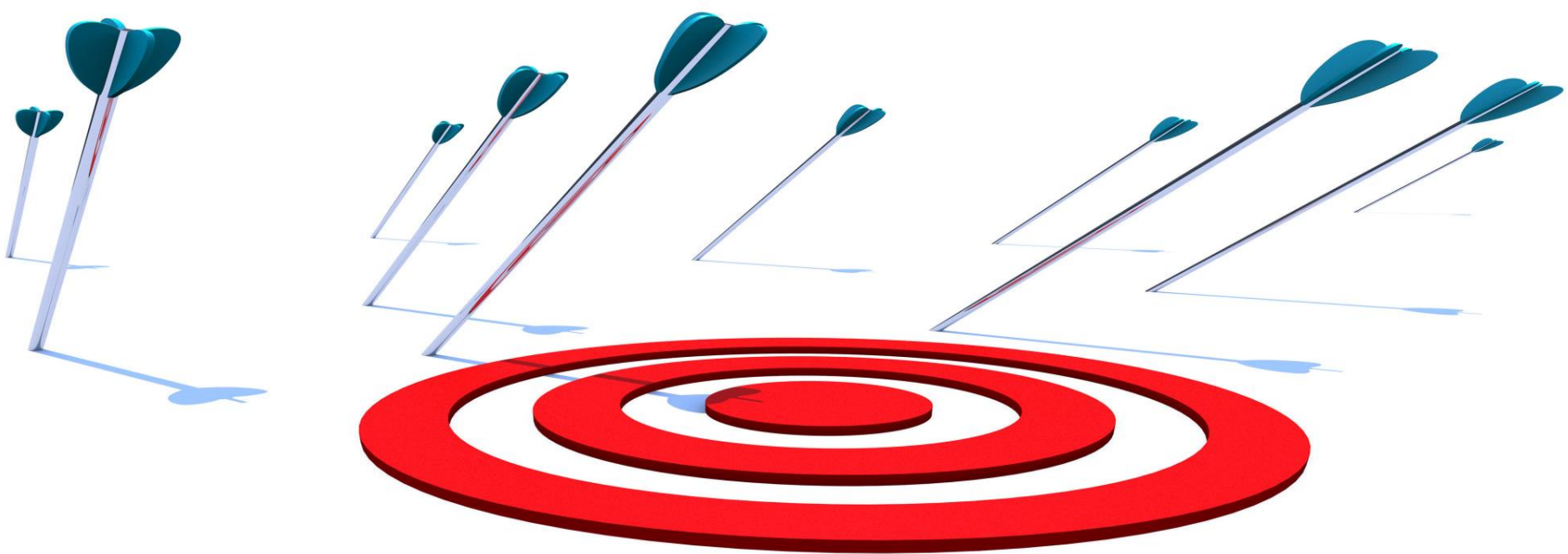
Who commits sex crimes?

Only 6% of all sex crimes are committed by a Registered Sex Offender.

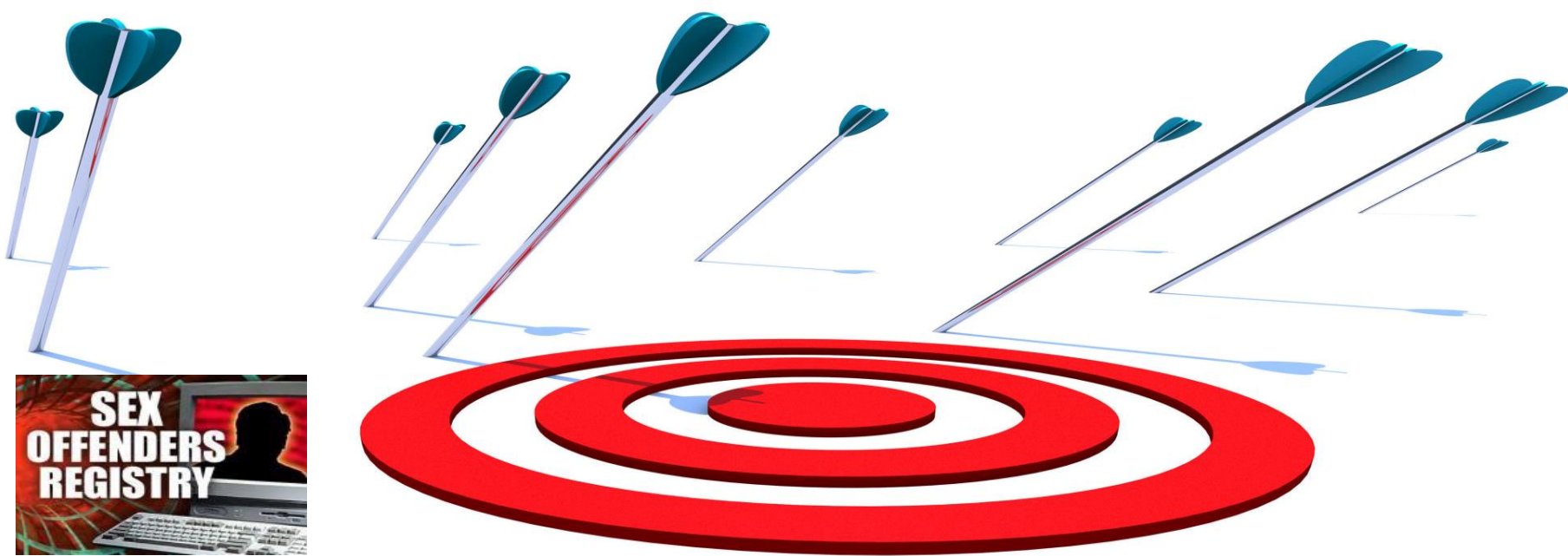

3 Recommendations To Improve Public Safety and Reduce Sex Offending

1. Minimize the “Stranger Danger” Myth and focus on Family / Acquaintance Sex Abuse Education.
2. Eliminate Public Notification since it shames and humiliates innocent SOR family members.
3. Reduce the SOR list by 94% and the remaining 6% be only available by law enforcement for parole and probation sex offenders only.
