

STOP HB 3253 A

Requires sex offender who is released into Oregon, who is placed on probation in Oregon or who moves into Oregon, to register as sex offender if jurisdiction of conviction requires registration









Who commits sex crimes?




Only 6% of all sex crimes are committed by a Registered Sex Offender.


94% of all sex crimes are committed by first-time sex offenders.

2. <u>Eliminate Public Notification</u> since it shames and humiliates innocent SOR family members.

3. <u>Reduce the SOR list by 94%</u> and the remaining 6% be only available by law enforcement for parole and probation sex offenders only.
