HB 2821-A, harmful legislation that upon approval would have three negative consequences for Oregon motorists. **First**, it would increase the cost of Personal Injury Protection (PIP) insurance by an estimated \$55.6 million by mandating a claimant fully recover economic and noneconomic damages. **Second**, HB 2821-A would lead to an increase in Underinsured Motorist (UIM) coverage as the amount already recovered from the at-fault driver will not be off-set under the new policy. **Finally**, this bill would extend the eligibility period for claim payments under PIP coverage from one to two years.
