### Senate Bill 208

Senate Bill (SB) 208 exempts the Oregon State Board of Examiners for Engineering and Land Surveying (OSBEELS) from Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 670.010. The proposed language allows OSBEELS to consider education as a relevant factor in lieu of a degree for licensure as a professional land surveyor.

**Summary:** The Bill also proposes the following housekeeping revisions:

- Allows OSBEELS to administer computer-based examinations as well as continuing to administer written examinations.
- Revises the position title of board secretary to administrator.

**Support and Opposition:** OSBEELS has received support from Oregon State University, George Fox University, University of Portland, Portland State University and Oregon Institute of Technology. One professor from Oregon State University submitted opposition.

**Fiscal Impact:** There should be no fiscal impact to this proposed legislation.
