


Intercollegiate Athletics Funding Sources - Definitions


- *Operating revenues*: Season ticket sales, gate receipts, concessions, parking, guarantees, post-season revenues, conference revenues, sponsorship income, and other sales and fee income.
- *Student Fees*: The portion of incidental fees that student governments allocate to athletics either as direct support to the department or in exchange for student tickets to athletic events
- *Lottery Proceeds*: Statutory allocation of Lottery monies to support intercollegiate athletics
- *Gifts, Grants and Booster Receipts*: Donations and fundraising proceeds to support athletic scholarships and athletic programs
- *Royalties and Interest*: Royalties from trademark licensing and interest on cash balances
- *Institutional Funds Subsidy*: Fee remissions granted to athletes and direct funding to athletics from the institution



Funding Sources Eastern Oregon University Intercollegiate Athletics FY 2012 -\$2,303,768




Funding Sources Oregon Tech Intercollegiate Athletics FY 2012 -\$2,236,794






Funding Sources Oregon State University Intercollegiate Athletics FY 2012 -\$53,784,730






Funding Sources Portland State University Intercollegiate Athletics FY 2012 -\$13,067,577






Funding Sources Southern Oregon University Intercollegiate Athletics FY 2012 -\$2,687,847
