# HB 2585 Relating to safety in public education programs

HB 2585 directs the State Board of Education to adopt a process for receiving and investigating complaints about the use of physical restraint or seclusion in schools, and requires entities that have jurisdiction over public education programs to submit annual reports on the use of physical restraint or seclusion in schools to the Superintendent of Public Instruction. In addition, the bill appropriates \$102,674 General Fund for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of this bill.

The Education Subcommittee recommends HB 2585 be amended and reported out do pass, as amended.
