

House Bill 2421
Relating to communication between state agencies
regarding members of uniformed services

HB 2421 instructs the Oregon Department of Transportation Director (ODOT) to share names and addresses of service members and veterans with the Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs Director (ODVA) on a monthly basis when service members or veterans make written inquiry regarding applications for licenses, identification cards, certificates of vehicle title, or vehicle registrations. The measure requires the service member's or veteran's written authorization to release his or her name and address to ODVA.

The measure includes a \$100,000 General Fund appropriation to the Department of Transportation, Driver and Motor Vehicle Services and approval of 0.34 fulltime equivalent positions. Costs are for programming, Department of Justice rule review, set-up charges, and manual workload to process applications.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends House Bill 2421 be amended and reported out do pass, as amended.

Summary of Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee Action

House Bill 2421-B relates to communication between state agencies regarding members of uniformed services. The measure is effective January 1, 2014. It instructs the Oregon Department of Transportation Director (ODOT) to share names and addresses of service members and veterans with the Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs Director (ODVA) on a monthly basis when service members or veterans make a written inquiry regarding applications for licenses, identification cards, certificates of vehicle title, or vehicle registrations. House Bill 2421-B requires the service member's or veteran's written authorization to release his or her name and address to ODVA. The bill authorizes ODOT to adopt rules, in consultation with ODVA, regarding method of implementing notification procedure.

The subcommittee approved a \$100,000 General Fund appropriation and added 0.34 FTE to ODOT for costs associated with programming, Department of Justice rule review, set-up charges and workload to process the subject applications.

4 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act becomes operative on Jan-**
5 **uary 1, 2014.**

6 **“SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
7 **ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Transportation, for**
8 **the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the**
9 **amount of \$100,000 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of**
10 **section 1 of this 2013 Act.**

11 **“SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate**
12 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
13 **declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect July 1, 2013.”.**

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
