A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transportation.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Transportation shall conduct a 5 study of the efficacy and cost of creating and implementing a system 6 for issuing distinctively marked driver licenses, driver permits and 7 identification cards to persons under 18 years of age.

8 (2) The department shall report the results of the study, along with
9 any recommendations, to the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly not
10 later than January 30, 2015.

- 11 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2016.
