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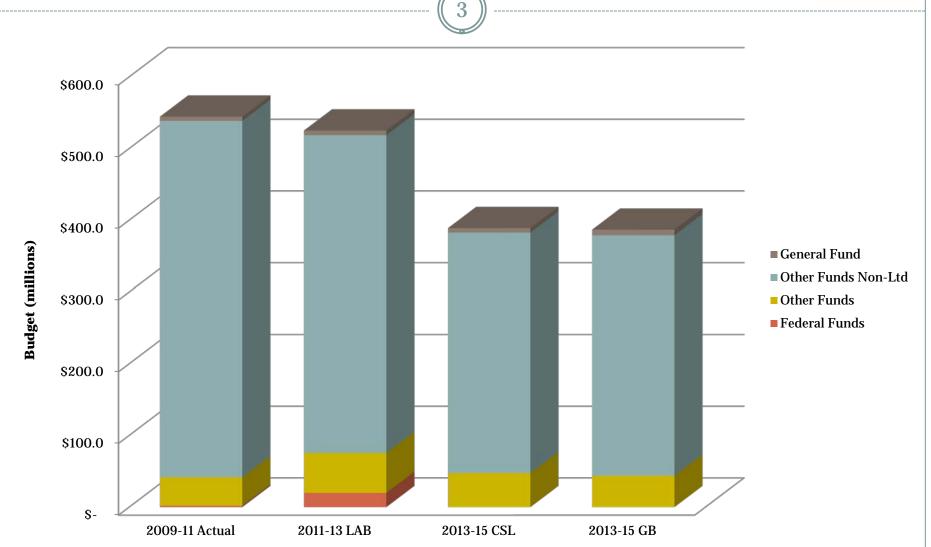

Department of Veterans' Affairs Expenditure History/2013-15 Governor's Budget

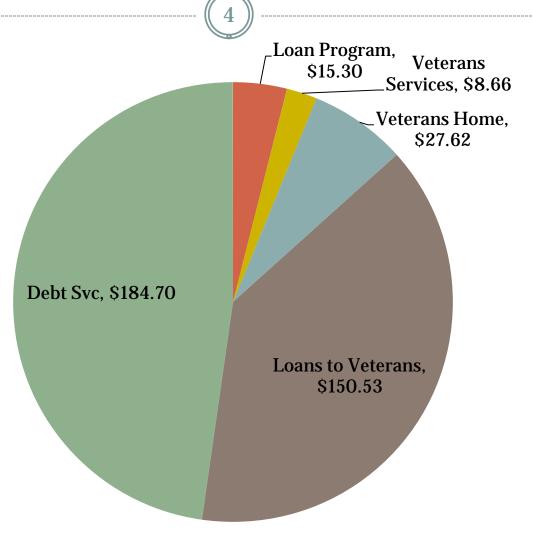

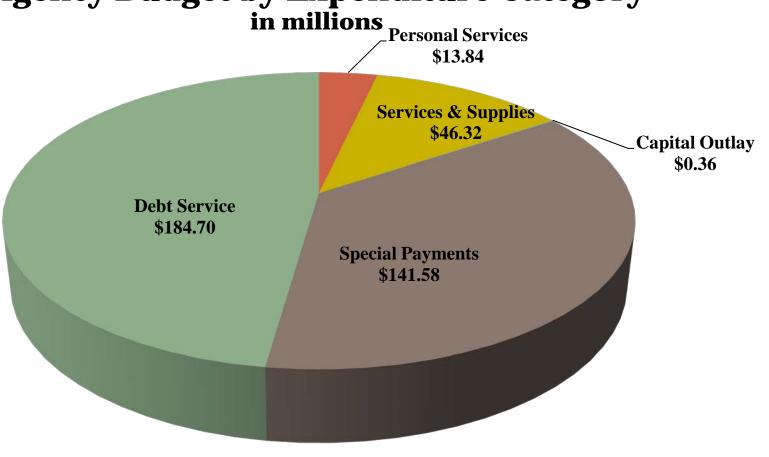

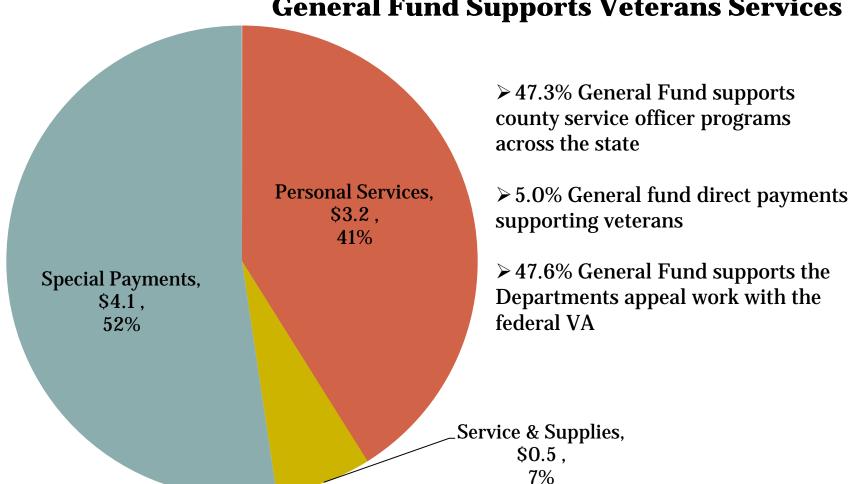
Agency Budget by Expenditure Category

Revenue Sources





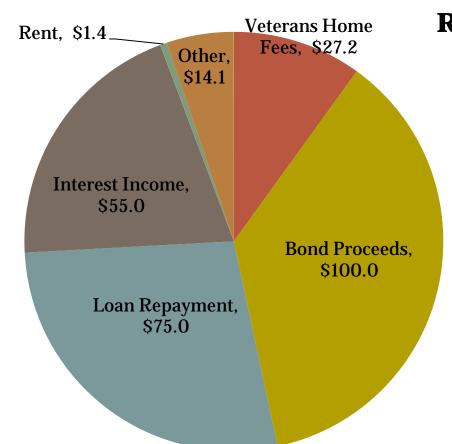
Revenues are Other Funds and General Fund
