# Overview

- Oregon's major academic health center
- Four schools: Medicine, Nursing, Dentistry, Pharmacy
  - Educate roughly 4400 students and trainees
- Large health system – two hospitals
  - More than 875,000 patient visits/year
  - More than half of our patients come from outside of Portland
- Large and growing research mission
  - \$359 million last year (trend up even as ARRA sunsets)
- Largest employer in Portland: 14,000+ employees
  - Generate ~\$4 billion in regional economic activity
- Statewide mission – 96,000 square mile campus

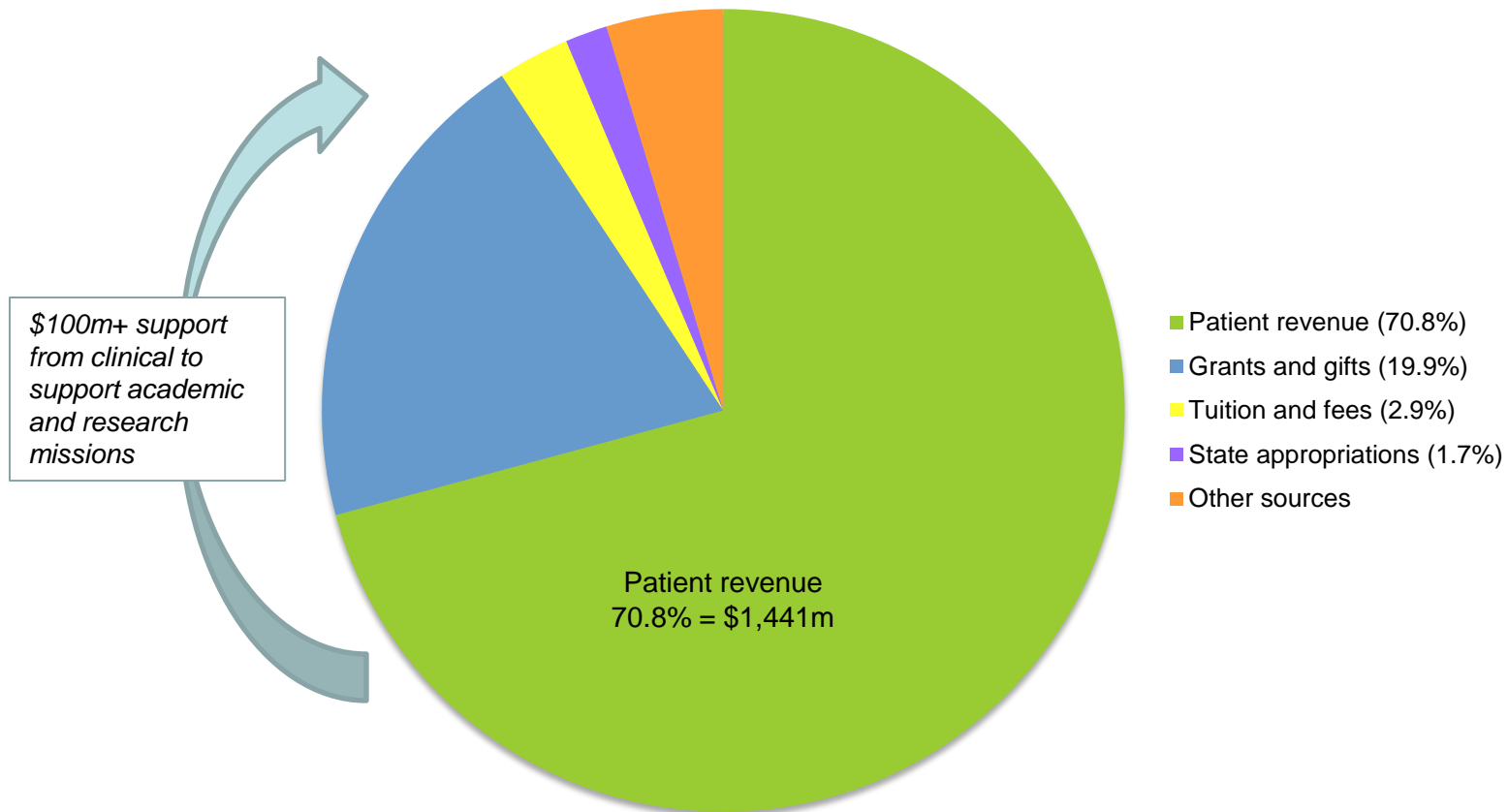


# Background on OHSU

- OHSU is a non-profit public corporation and is the state's major academic medical center.
- As a public corporation, OHSU receives yearly appropriation from the state.
- The OHSU Board of Directors has 10 members.
  - Mandated positions on the board include the president of OHSU, a member of the Oregon State Board of Higher Education and an OHSU student.
  - The other seven members serve at the governor of Oregon's discretion and must be confirmed by the Oregon Senate.
  - Charles Wilhoite currently serves as chairman.
- Coordinate with OUS on academic programs.

# OHSU Education

- ~4400 students and trainees
  - 2849 students in OHSU degree programs
  - 454 students in joint degree programs
  - 1102 interns, residents, fellows, and trainees
- 4 Schools
  - Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, Pharmacy (joint program w/OSU)
