WHAT THE BILL DOES: Revises the method by which the State School Fund grants for the Juvenile Development Education Program (JDEP) are calculated. Redefines the JDEP to include the provision of educational services to youths placed in a youth care center within in a specified detention facility. Takes effect on July 1, 2013.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:

BACKGROUND: Currently, the Juvenile Development Education Program (JDEP) receives the general purpose grant from the State School Fund (SSF) based on the Average Daily Membership (ADM) multiplied by 1.5. This bill increases the multiplying factor from 1.5 to 2. It also stipulates that the extended weighted ADM (extended ADMw) be used in distributing the SSF to the JDEP.

The current law defines the JDEP as the provision of educational services to youths lodged overnight who receive educational services on consecutive days within a specified detention facility.
