My name is Carroll Dressler and I live in Bend. I urge you not to pass HB 2306. As I believe all politics is local, I feel this bill is yet another example of government overreach. I do not think it is appropriate for a governor, of any party, to choose a county commissioner should a vacancy in that office occur. That task is best given to the people of the county, and in particular the PCPs who are elected by the people of their respective counties.
