BACKGROUND: Andrew Keller, of Portland, Oregon, was killed by insurgents in Afghanistan on August 15, 2012, leading his team in combat. He proudly served in the United States Army for eighteen months, and had just deployed to Afghanistan a month before his death. He was 22. He received the Bronze Star, a Purple Heart, and an Army Commendation Medal. Senate Concurrent Resolution 9 honors him.
