# PRIVATE FORESTS DIVISION

## **Purpose** Keeping private forestlands healthy, intact, and working

## **Oregon Forest Practices Act**

- Cornerstone of forest resource protection on private forestlands in Oregon
- Enacted in 1971, nation's first comprehensive law governing forest practices
- Evolves over time as knowledge and practices change

Public Policy: ensure the continuous growing and harvesting of forest tree species

## How Policy Works Act Requires:

Scientifically supported best management practices for all aspects of forestry

- Effectiveness monitoring and rational rule-making process
- Input from regional forest practice committees
- Annual meetings with agencies that affect or are impacted by forest practices
- Uniform enforcement of rules

### FPA Implementation Protecting Natural Resources

- Stewardship foresters in local district offices enforce Forest Practices Act on 10.7 million acres
- Accept notifications and review operations for protected resources
- Prioritized field inspections to avoid resource damage and ensure compliance

## Outcomes

- Oregon leads nation in softwood lumber and plywood production
- Oregon's forest sector provide 76,000 jobs
- 90 % percent of forested sites showed good or excellent water quality
- 98 % of Oregon's wildland forests remain as wildland forest
