Dear Chair Tomei and Members of the Committee:

O4AD, representing the 17 Area Agencies on Aging and Disabilities, is pleased to offer our support of HB 2712, which sets forward an advisory committee to assist the Department of Human Services in providing recommendations for the General Assistance program.

Area Agencies were providers of the General Assistance program when it was a service offered to Oregon's vulnerable individuals. The program offered a small amount of assistance to a very distinct group of individuals with disabilities who were waiting for their federal benefits to begin. General Assistance, a temporary state benefit, provides necessary support for medical care and a stipend that can help an individual afford rent and medications until they are able to attain their federal benefits. Funds for this program are reimbursed to the state.

As a state, we are looking carefully at how we can increase our investment in prevention and early interventions to help individuals achieve better health and better outcomes with lower cost. General Assistance is an excellent example of a program that makes sense and reaches those goals by avoiding high cost emergency interventions for an individual who is in that difficult 'middle ground' of waiting for their benefits to begin.

O4AD supports HB 2712 and welcomes being a part of this dialogue.
