SUMMARY

Permits nonattorney to represent person at proceeding before Department of Transportation involving registration of commercial vehicles.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to nonattorney representation at a proceeding conducted by the
3 Department of Transportation; amending ORS 823.035.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 823.035 is amended to read:

6 823.035. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 9.320 and 823.031 (2), an individual who
7 is not an attorney may represent that individual or other persons who con-
8 sent to such representation at any proceeding before the Department of
9 Transportation involving the regulation of transportation matters pursuant
10 to ORS chapter 825.

11 (2) Notwithstanding ORS 9.320 and 823.031 (2), an individual who is not
12 an attorney may represent that individual or labor organizations, railroads,
13 motor carriers or government agencies who consent to such representation
14 in any proceeding before the department involving the regulation of trans-
15 portation matters pursuant to ORS 824.020 to 824.042, 824.050 to 824.110 and
16 824.200 to 824.256.

17 **(3) Notwithstanding ORS 9.320 and 823.031 (2), an individual who is**
18 **not an attorney may represent that individual or other persons who**
19 **consent to such representation in any proceeding before the depart-**
20 **ment involving the regulation of transportation matters pursuant to**
21 **ORS chapter 826.**

1 ~~[(3)]~~ **(4)** Any compromises, agreements, admissions, stipulations, state-
2 ments of fact or other such action taken by the representative at any such
3 proceeding is binding on those represented to the same extent as if done by
4 an attorney. A person so represented may not thereafter claim that any such
5 proceeding was legally defective because the person was not represented by
6 an attorney.

7 ~~[(4)]~~ **(5)** As used in this section, “attorney” has the meaning for that term
8 provided in ORS 9.005.
