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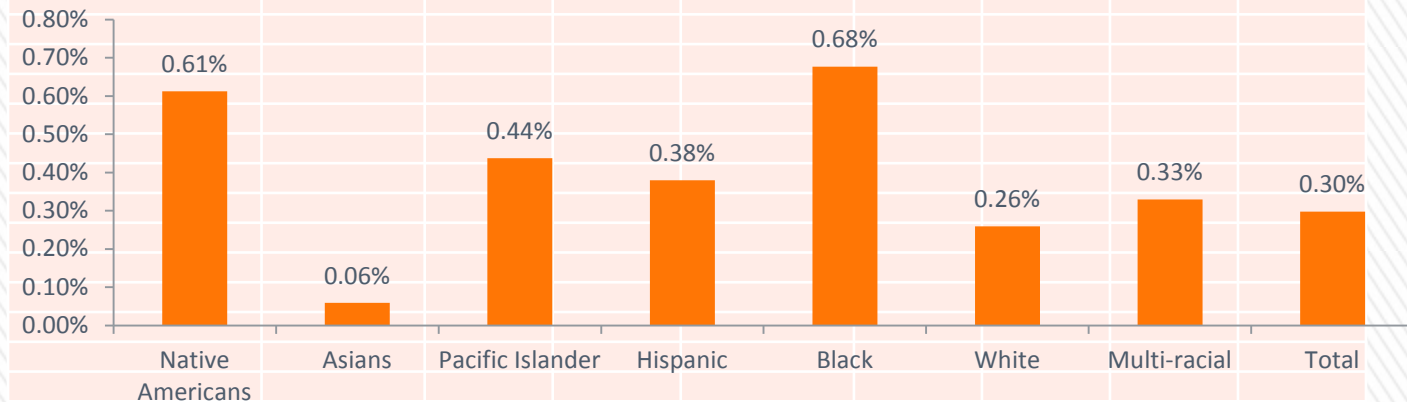

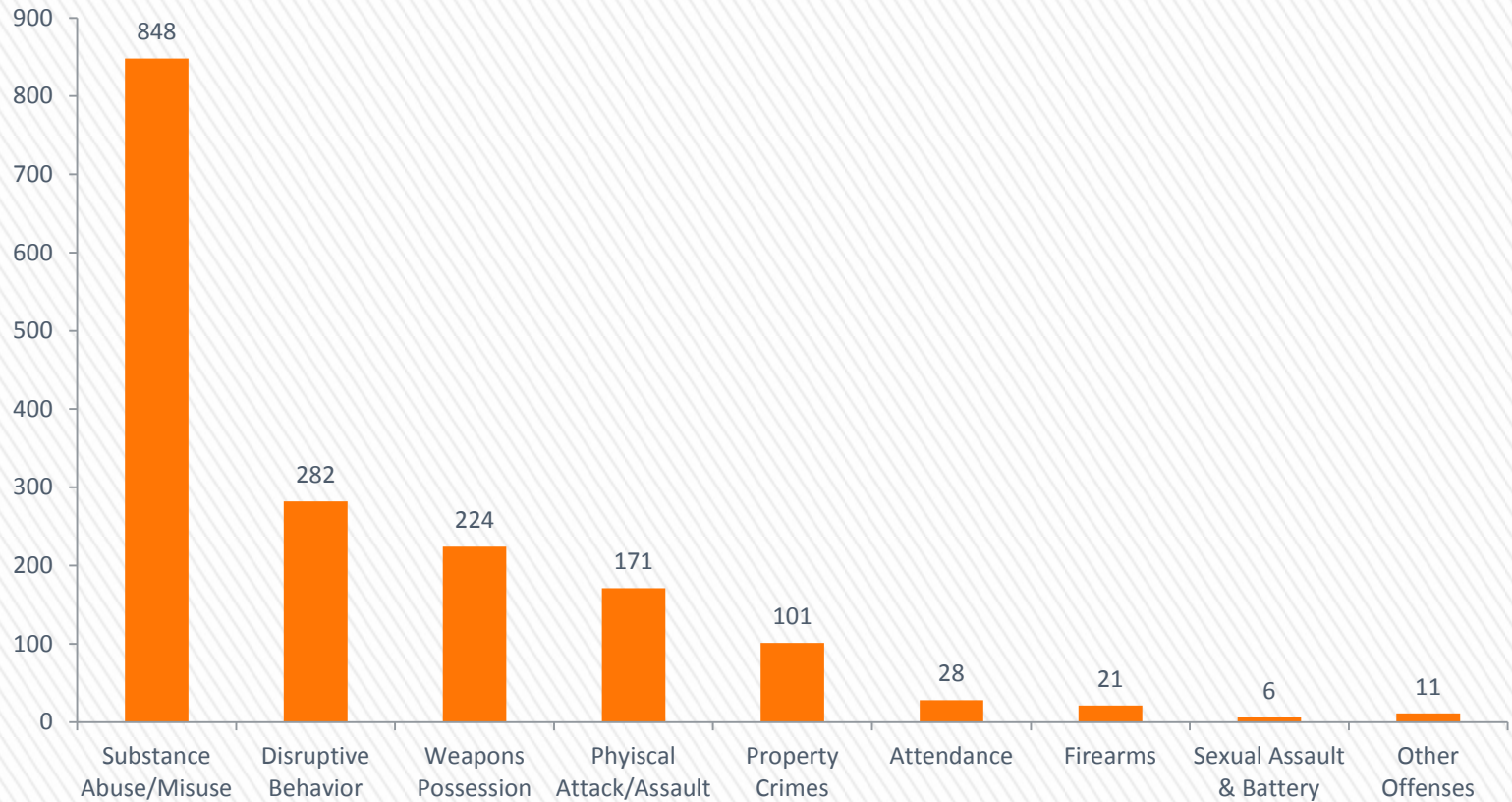
% of Expulsions by Race/Ethnicity (# of expulsions divided by total # of students in particular Race)



Expulsions – Race & Ethnicity, 2011-12



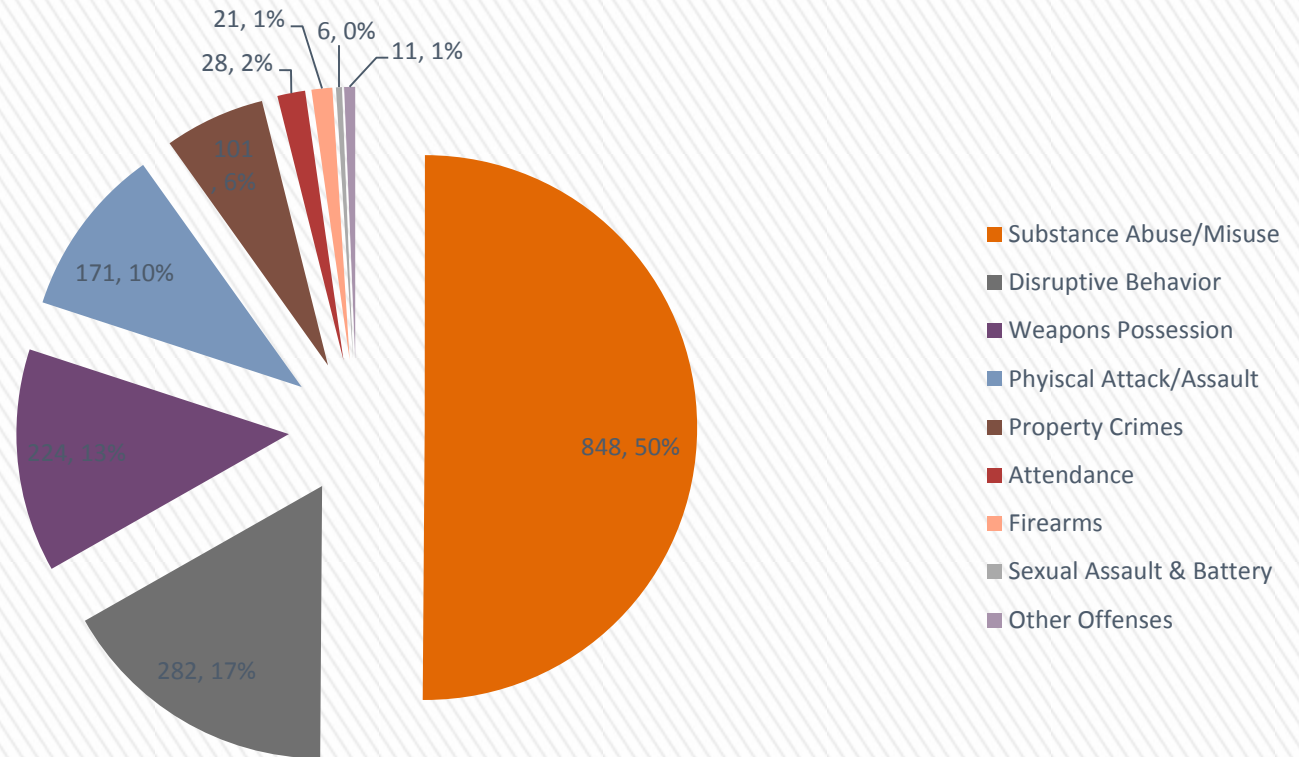

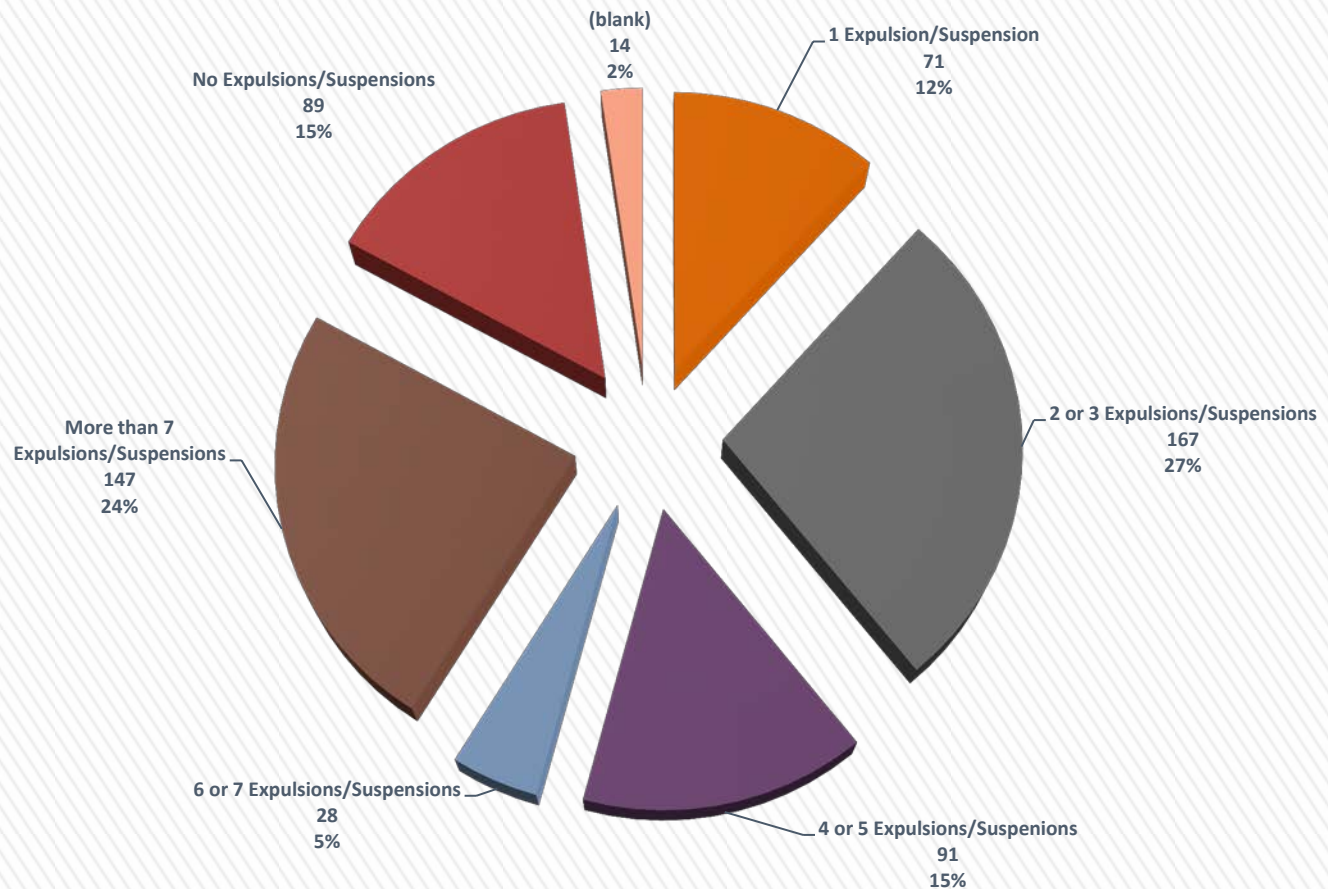


Expulsions/Out of School Suspensions

Juvenile and DOC Commitments
All Youth



- » *'School to Prison' Pipeline*
- » *Delinquency*
- » ***85% of incarcerated juveniles have been expelled from school at least once and multiple times.***
- » *Substance Abuse*
- » *Depression*
- » *Violence*
- » *Alienation*
- » *Lost Instructional Time*
