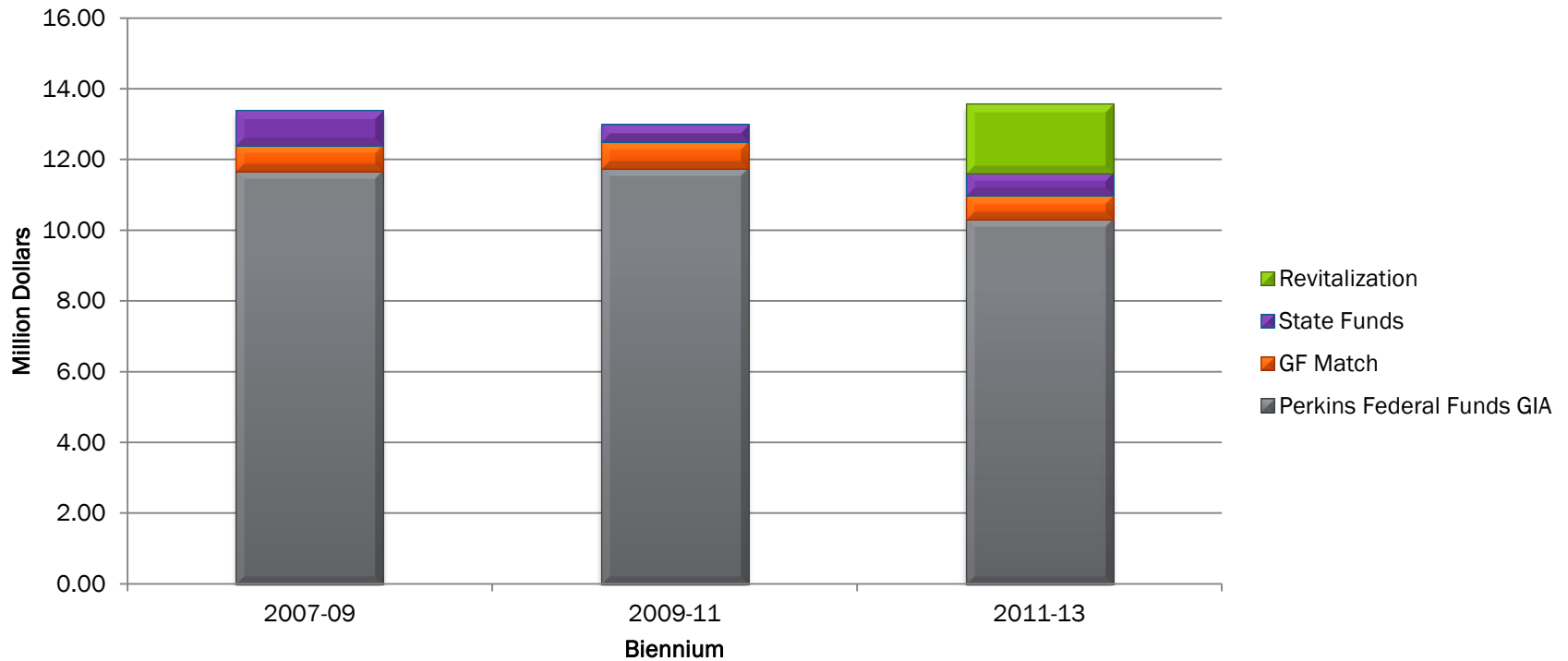

Secondary Career and Technical Education Funding



A general fund match is required to remain eligible for Perkins federal funds.

State funds include funds earmarked for the student leadership center and in 2011-13 includes Science and Technology FIRST and Accelerated College Credit grants.

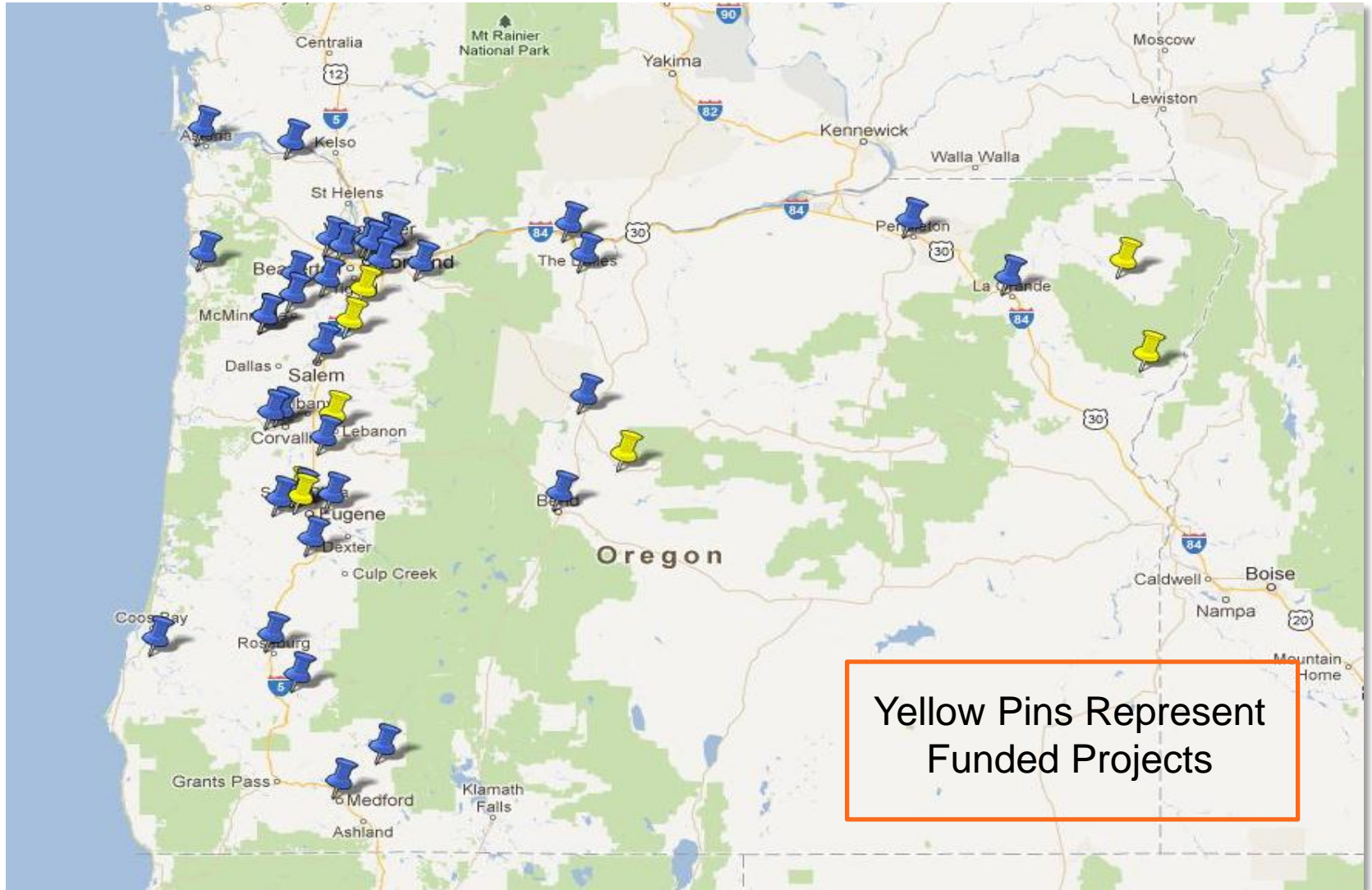
