Citizens' Initiative Review Commission Agency Overview



- The Citizens' Initiative Review Commission was established by the Oregon Legislature in 2011 (House Bill 2634)
- The Citizens' Initiative Review Commission was established to be an innovative way of publicly evaluating ballot measures so voters have clear and useful information about ballot measures at election time.
- During the review, a panel of randomly-selected, demographically-balanced voters comes together to fairly evaluate a ballot measure. The panel hears directly from campaigns for and against the measure and calls upon policy experts during the multi-day public review.


