## Re: House Bill 2161 – Professional Licensure for Military Spouses/Domestic Partners

The Oregon Health Licensing Agency (OHLA) is a state licensing and regulatory agency providing oversight to multiple volunteer citizen boards and their health and related professions.

The agency believes that House Bill 2161 provides sufficient flexibility to allow for establishing by administrative rule an efficient and streamlined process to determine demonstrated competency and issue authorizations to practice for military spouses or domestic partners who are subject to military transfer to Oregon.

The agency will work with military families to carry out the provisions of this bill if passed into law.
