



OSAC Organizational Chart





ASPIRE Statistics

- For 2011-12
 - 138 sites
 - 74,786 student participants
 - 1,543 volunteer mentors
 - Student-to-mentor ratio 5:1
- Projected Growth
 - 145 sites in 2012-13
 - 185 sites in 2013-14
 - 295 sites by end of 2013-15
