




### State Lands Revenue Sources









#### • Investments:

- Ongoing legal costs for possible Portland Harbor defense.
- Miscellaneous issues
  - ▼ Increase Common School Fund program expenditure level to cover property tax on former Eugene Motor Pool property.
  - **▼** South Slough National Research Reserve
    - Program efficiencies self-funded position reclassifications
    - Watershed stewardship implement forest management, climate change and watershed management plans.
  - ➤ Capital improvements to protect asset values Salem headquarters heating and ventilation system.

#### • Investments continued:

- Revenue shortfalls
  - ▼ South Slough National Estuarine Research Reserve Federal Funds projected to be less than in past biennia.

 Updates to DAS Price List and State Government Services Charges, placeholder for Statewide Administrative Savings, PERS Rate and PERS Policy adjustments

### State Lands 2013-15 Adjustments to Governor's Budget



#### Post-publication issues

- Add Other Funds to Portland Harbor.
- Environmental Protection Agency grant work will finish in the 2013-15 biennium – add \$0.4 million Other Funds expenditure limitation.
- South Slough National Estuarine Research Reserve grant work will finish in the 2013-15 biennium – add \$0.08 million Other Funds expenditure limitation.
- Close out Natural Heritage Advisory Council duties Yamhill County grant completion in the 2013-15 biennium. Add \$0.1 million Federal Funds expenditure limitation.
