Requires that at least 20 percent of the revenue collected from taxes on cigarettes or tobacco products be used for public health programs or services. Takes effect on the 91st day after adjournment sine die.

BACKGROUND: Current law specifies that the taxes on cigarettes and tobacco products are in lieu of all other state, county or municipal taxes on the sale or use of cigarettes and tobacco products (ORS 323.030 and ORS 323.640).
