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





• Promotes the public interest through the responsible sale and service of alcoholic beverages.

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- Administers Oregon's Liquor Control Act:
 - × Distributes liquor through retail agents
 - × Licenses, educates, and regulates alcoholic beverage sellers
 - × Oversees alcohol server education
 - × Issues permits
 - × Enforces alcohol laws
- Administers Oregon's Bottle Bill







Oregon Liquor Control Commission Revenue Sources



- Other Fund revenues are derived from liquor sales, wine and malt beverage privilege taxes, licensing fees, permits, and fines.
- Revenues fund Commission operations and provide distributions to:
 - Oregon Wine Board
 - Mental Health, Alcoholism and Drug Services Account.
 - o General Fund
 - Cities
 - Counties

Oregon Liquor Control Commission 2013-15 Governor's Budget/Technical Adjustments



- Investment in a liquor agent apprenticeship program.
 - Focuses on increasing the representation of demographically under-represented groups in the pool of liquor agents.
- Increase in revenue to reflect anticipated growth in liquor sales.
