Provided for in Oregon's Constitution. In Article II Section 18 Current recall efforts would require 15% of signatures to bring an officer to a Recall.

This proposal bill removes this citizen's power to choose whom they trust to conduct their elections or recall that officer. In its place it establishes an expensive bureaucracy to investigate, bring to a hearing and removal of an elections officer This bill takes the citizens completely out of the process.
