WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Permits customers to operate appropriately equipped gas pumps when ordered to evacuate in an emergency.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

[pending amendment] Replaces the measure. Requires installation of generator drop at all new gas stations, and upon remodel or upgrade of existing stations.

BACKGROUND: Oregon law prohibits individuals from pumping their own gas. Senate Bill 127 creates an exception to permit retail customers to serve themselves at pumps that are capable of completing the transaction, if they have been ordered to evacuate during a state of emergency.
