WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires phone operators to enable public safety answering points (PSAPs) to obtain street address and building name at minimum, from automatic location identification database (ALID) for 9-1-1 calls. Exempts operators of key telephone systems, wireless telecommunications, and multiline systems serving single level, single tract structures of 10,000 square feet or less. Requires diligent efforts by managers to ensure user awareness of 9-1-1 call procedure. Requires operators to arrange ALID update upon installation of new phone system to enable PSAPS to obtain 9-1-1 caller address and callback number. Provides civil immunity for 9-1-1 jurisdictions and complying providers, manufacturers, managers, and operators. Defines terms. Applies to multiline telephone systems installed a year or more after passage.
