WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Removes requirement that annual earthquake drills be held in April, for employers of 250 or more full-time employees.

BACKGROUND: April was chosen as *the* month for earthquake drills because it is National Earthquake and Tsunami month. Oregon additionally recognizes an earthquake and tsunami day in March. Emergency preparedness efforts occur year-round in Oregon. House Bill 2183 provides employers with more flexibility to arrange and scheduling drills.
