FEDERAL MAINTENACE OF EFFORT

 Maintenance of Effort (MOE) consists of state dollars expended by the state library (State Library Administrative Agency (SLAA) for federal purposes) for library programs that are consistent with the purposes of the Library Services and Technology Act (improving library services, access to library services, resource sharing, literacy, librarian workforce skills, knowledge preservation, information infrastructure)

- In order to receive full IMLS funding a state must meet the MOE requirements
- The amount otherwise payable to a state for a fiscal year pursuant to an allotment...shall be reduced if the level of state expenditures...for the previous fiscal year is less than the average of the total of such expenditures for the 3 fiscal years preceding that previous fiscal year.
